

School Fees and Book Deposit

Textbook deposit:

On average, each student is issued with textbooks valued in excess of \$300.00. In an effort to ensure that students take responsibility for the care of texts and library materials, each student will be assessed a book deposit of \$30.00. This deposit will be credited to the student when books are returned in satisfactory condition. Any unreasonable damage or loss will be charged against this deposit. In addition, students will be billed for any damages which exceed the \$30.00 deposit. This deposit will cover library books, textbooks and other materials used by the student.

In order to assist families with more than one child in school there is a graduated fee schedule: first child \$30.00, second child \$20.00, third child \$10.00.

No family shall be required to pay more than a \$60.00 textbook deposit.

Locker Deposit:

A further \$5.00 fee will be assessed for locks for lockers. Students must use school locks. The student will be refunded this \$5.00 deposit if the lock is returned in satisfactory condition by the end of the school year and his/her lock; text book sheet is submitted to the office. Note: Students are reminded that the school has the right to search lockers when the administration deems it necessary.

Refund of Deposits:

Only those students leaving Watson Lake Secondary School will receive a cheque for the value of their deposit less any losses or damages. All other students who have handed in their textbook return form and qualify for a credit will have their deposit carried forward to the following year. If the student does not qualify for full credit, the deposit will have to be topped up the following year.

Gym Lockers

Lockers are available in the gymnasium change rooms. The cost of the lock is \$5.00 per year.

Industrial Arts, Fine Arts and other Project Based Courses:

Fees may be required in project based courses to pay for special student projects.
